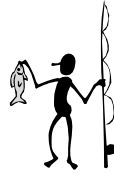

- **PART 1: All-School Day Trip to Arroyo**

- ▶ We will continue our practice of beginning school on the first Thursday after Labor Day. This year, that means that our first day of school will be **Thursday, September 9**. You’ll receive information about student schedules and class selections in August, but—for now—circle that starting date on your calendars!
- ▶ Winter Break will be **Saturday, December 18 – Sunday, January 2** (inclusive). School will resume on Monday, January 3.
